	In School Learning	Home Learning
English	Last week, students continued to explore the myth 'Theseus' and the Minotaur. They used text maps to learn and perform sections of the text and explore to language and structural features of this text.	Myth comparison Select a myth from http://myths.e2bn.org/mythsandlegends/ which would you like to read. Summarise the myth using bullet points or in pictures by creating a storyboard. How does it compare to Theseus and the Minotaur? What are the similarities? What is different?
Maths	Last week, students applied their knowledge of addition and subtraction to solve problems. They also completed and end of unit assessment to see how much they have learnt in this unit.	Problem solving Select one or more of the following problems to solve: Mild: https://nrich.maths.org/1130 Spicy: https://nrich.maths.org/1885 Hot: https://nrich.maths.org/7506 Fiery: https://nrich.maths.org/1044/index You can show your workings out in your homework book. Think, you may need to use pictures or diagrams to help you.
Science	Students investigated which materials will dissolve in a liquid to form a solution and how to recover a substance from a solution.	Science homework will be a follow up task from the Question a Day questions students completed last week. These will be differentiated to help address misconceptions identified from the results of the class.
Integrated Curriculum	Students began looking at Roman artefacts and considering what they might tell us about the past.	Optional task: Start researching to find out more about the Romans. Select an area that interests you (e.g. Gladiators, Roman army, houses, schools, inventions) and record your notes in your homework book. This will help you when we start creating our PowerPoint presentations next week.
