	Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Subtract a 1 digit number from a 2 digit number crossing ten. Eg. <math>24 - 6 = \dots\dots\dots 24 - 4 = 20</math> and then <math>20 - 2 = 18</math></li> <li>Explain my method of subtraction.</li> <li>Use a variety of subtraction words – less, fewer, difference between, takeaway, minus, subtract, left over</li> </ul>
	Other Subjects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive.</li> </ul>
