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Home learning this week:

Spelling

Look at **lists 6-10 on the new spelling sheet** in the front of the homework books. Practice the spelling patterns and rules for a review test of some of the words on Thursday.

Writing: Write an information text about The Ancient Egyptians. Try to write two or three paragraphs (but no more than one page). You could write about hieroglyphics, the pyramids, Canopic jars, mummies, the River Nile or any other part of Ancient Egyptian life. If you use the internet to search remember to use the safe search engine Kiddle but do not copy the information you find, instead use your own words.

Reading: Read home readers as often as possible together with any other reading material. Look at the note in the front of your reading journal to explain how to record reading. These books must be changed at least once **every week**.
