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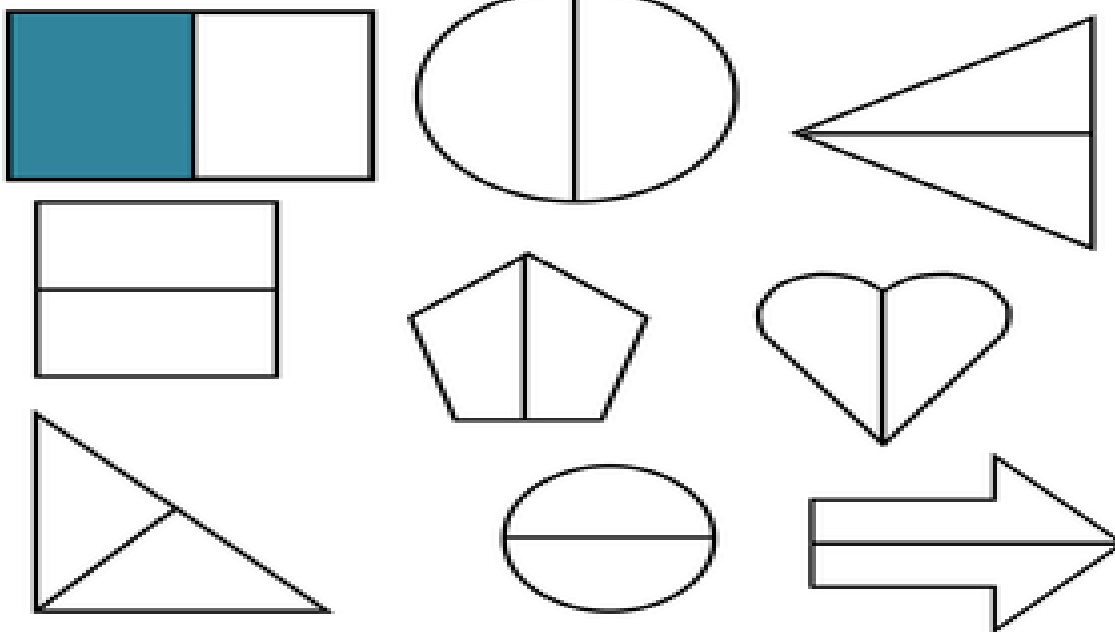

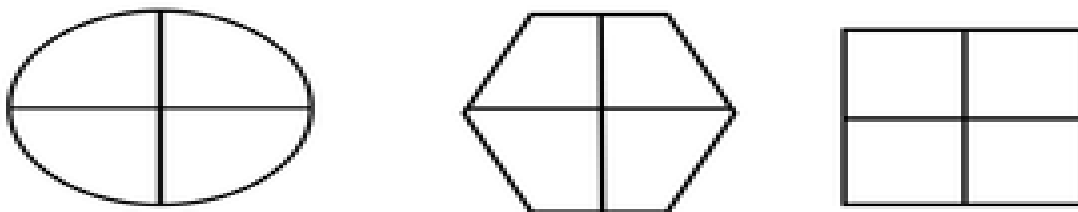
\*Practise the 2, 5 and 10 times table for 10 minutes every day.
