	In School Learning	Home Learning
English	This week, students will plan and create their own independent story with suspense, including the features they learnt about last term.	Verb tenses Choose the level to best challenge you and practise changing verbs into the past tense. Click here to view the task. Complete in your homework book.
Maths	In maths, students will use line graphs to solve word problems. They will then learn how to read and solve problems involving timetables.	Problem solving Can you solve this fractions problem ? Use the interactive resource to try different solutions and once you have solved each of the challenges, draw your solutions into your homework book.
Science	In science, students will visit the Cosmic Dome planetarium. Following this, they will begin to explore how to investigate scientific questions related to space.
