

	In School Learning	Home Learning
English	This week, students will be writing poems. In recent guided reading sessions, we have been exploring figurative language techniques. Students will now have the opportunity apply these skills to create their own poems.	Note taking skills Watch this video . Take notes on the key information as you watch. Maths	In maths, students will continue working on converting measures, both metric and imperial. They will then move on to learn about how to calculate the area of rectilinear compound shapes and find side lengths of a shape when given the perimeter or area. Science	In science, students will learn about the lunar month, developing their understanding of the different phases of the moon.
