Regular reading is vital to achieve academic success across the curriculum.

To help you better support your children at home here is a summary of what we will be teaching and learning in class this week.

What We Are Learning This Week

PATHS	English Language	We will be using Talk for Writing techniques to aid learning to retell our own version of The Green Ship story. We will be extending vocabulary use by looking at a greater range of adjectives and using them in 2A sentences (for example: We saw a <i>tall, brown</i> camel walking across the desert. To extend writing further we will be writing descriptions of scenes from the story.
	Maths	We will begin our unit of work on addition and subtraction by adding two digit numbers, to one and two digit numbers, leading onto three digits when secure.
	Integrated Curriculum	Healthy Eating: This week we will be exploring different breads from around the world and looking at the range of healthy sandwiches that can be produced. On Tuesday, we will be tasting a range of different breads in preparation for designing our own sandwiches.

**Year 3 Homework Week beginning 30/09/18**

Spelling/Writing: Look at list 3 in the front of the homework books. Learn the words for a test on Thursday by reading each word, covering it over, and trying to write from memory before checking. This is called Look, Cover, Write, Check. Do this at least three times for each word. Use at least 5 of your spelling words in interesting sentences. Write these neatly in your homework book. Try to use some adjectives and 2A sentences.

Reading: Try to read home readers as often as possible together with any other reading material. Look at the note in the front of your reading journal to explain how to record reading.

Maths: Addition and subtraction - write all the addition and subtraction number sentences you can find for

$$\bullet + \bullet = 30 \quad \text{and} \quad 30 - \bullet = \bullet \quad \text{For example: } 1 + 29 = 30, \quad 30 - 1 = 29,$$

Think about how to record your work, try to find a way to order your number sentences, then you will be able to see when you have found them all. Record them in your homework books. How many different number sentences can you make?

Challenge: How many different ways can you make 40 using addition and subtraction?

Science: Create a poster of the rock cycle.

Mental Maths: Log on to Time Tables Rock Stars using you log in details given and complete.
