**Home Learning:** Below is an outline of homework tasks which will be set next week and will be due on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> October.

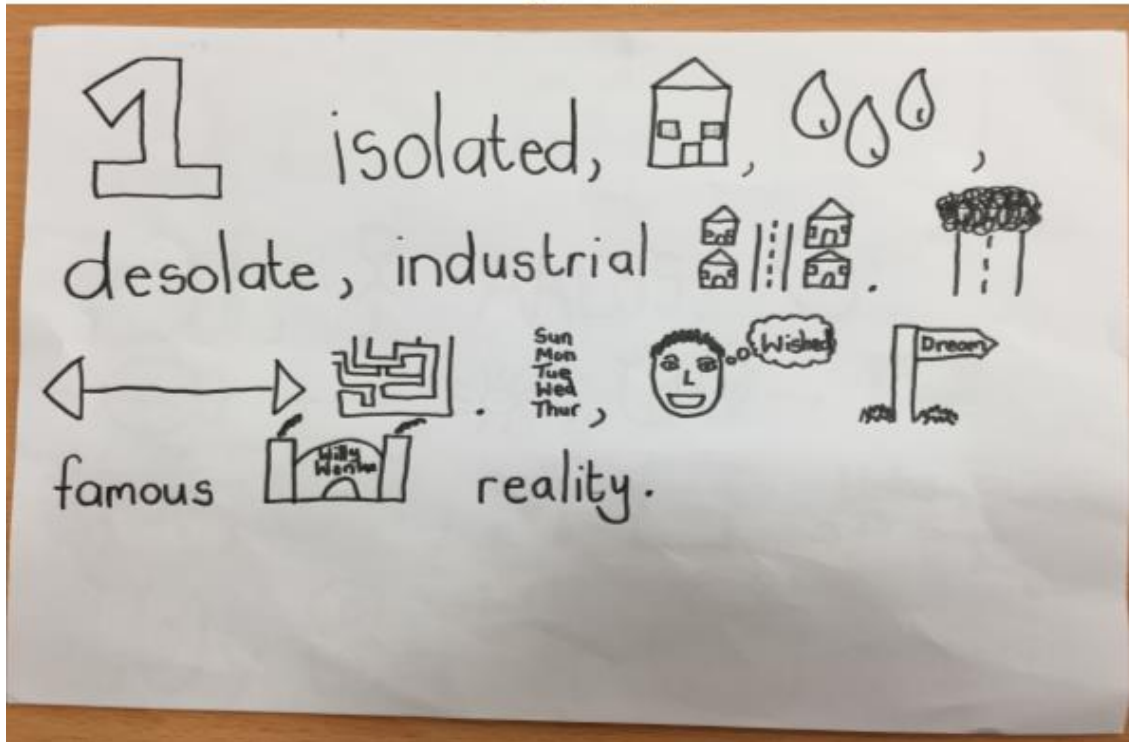

	In School Learning	Home Learning
English	In Talk4Writing, the children have been learning the first paragraph of our wishing tale text by using actions and pictures to help memorise it. This is part of the 'imitation' stage. In guided reading, the children have been looking at 'Charlie and The Chocolate factory'. The children have been exploring the different feelings and emotions within the book.	<b>Talk the text</b> Using the text map provided, practise 'Talking the Text'. House points are on offer if you can film yourself doing this and email to your teacher.  <b>Spellings</b> Please see spelling sheet stuck in homework book.  Spelling assessments will be conducted every Sunday during period 5. It is an important task and will show us how much the children have improved.
Maths	Our maths focus has been on Roman Numerals up to 100 and negative numbers (counting through zero). In the upcoming week, we will be drawing to a close our number and place value topic. The children will complete an assessment in order to show off how much they have learnt.	<b>Maths</b> Please see maths sheet stuck in their home learning book.  <b>Time Tables Rockstars</b>  Details for Times Tables Rockstars will be shared with children during the week. Look out for their username and password in their student planners.
Science	In science, children have begun their learning on the topic sound. Next week we will be exploring how sounds are made.	<b>Science</b> Identify 10 sounds that you hear around the house. Right the name of the sound and say if it is loud or soft.
Integrated Curriculum	In our 'Grand Designs' topic, we will be learning about the UAE's history and Abu Dhabi buildings/designs!	<b>Grand Designs</b> Write down 3 interesting facts about Sheikh Zayed in preparation for our learning this week on the history of the UAE.
